

SHOOT WITH ME

SWM 2017

- 24 groups
- Over 120 participants
- Diverse range of projects from long exposures to Autumn Moonshots, Sunrises, Sligo outing, Bokeh Effect, Dublin Docklands, Drogheda Port, Processing, Strobe Photography, Minimalist Landscapes, Light Trails, Steel Wool Photography, Fractured Mirror Portraits, Favourite Paintings, Sports Photography, Multiple Exposures, Copper Coast Outing, Botanic Gardens and the Brenizer Method
- Successful printed showcases held in May and December

HOW DOES IT WORK ?

- Shoot With Me is a project based activity, culminating in two printed image showcases held in May and December.
- We have 12 "volunteers" who lead a small group (usually about 4-6 people) on a photographic topic of their choice.
- The project/topic can be anything : places, landscape, macro, colours, movement, star trails, flowers, portraits, sport, long exposure – the list is endless.

TIMEFRAME FOR SPRING SWM

- January :Communication(s) seeking volunteers can't progress until they are in place!
- When we have 12 volunteers (hopefully in place by the end of the month), Helen will email all members with details of the projects and ask them to give me their preferences
- Projects are allocated on a *first come, first served* basis so you need to respond quickly as some projects fill very fast
- When projects have been filled, leaders will contact their group and finalise details
- Leaders will collect €12 upfront from their groups which is the cost of printing for the showcase
- Projects will need to be finished towards the end of April to allow time for submitting and printing images for the showcase in May

HOW CAN YOU HELP ?

- Lead a group ? You do *not need* to be an expert for your project. All you are required to do is facilitate a small group of fellow photographers – organise dates and places to meet and help bring the images to print.
- The objective here is to have some fun, socialize and learn from each other in a practical way. You won't be alone – there are loads of members willing to help out.
- Get involved !!!
