- Thanks to Mike for his enthusiasm and work done He is standing back and taking a less active role in Outings





TREASURER – PROJECTED RESULTS TO 31ST DECEMBER 2018

Notes

- 1. Seven new members paid the Annual Subscription between September and December and they have been credited with an advance payment of the 2019 subscription.
- 2. Sums received towards the expense of the Exhibition, Courses and similar items have been netted against the costs.
- 3. The deficit of €1,276 is a swing of €3,238 from the €1,962 surplus in 2017 Based on this the Committee is recommending an increase of the 2019 subscription fee from €80 to €90 to maintain the current cash on hand balance



SHOOT WITH ME

SWM 2018

- 24 groups
- 160 participants
- Diverse range of projects from Still Life to Surreal Storytelling, Light Painting, Photo merge, ICM, Water droplets, Macro, Capturing fog, Projected Graphics, Levitation, Smoke Photography, Spring flowers, Seascapes, Bubblemania etc
- Successful printed showcases held in May and December

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Shoot With Me is a project based activity, culminating in two printed image showcases held in May and December.
- We have 12 "volunteers" who lead a small group (usually about 4-6 people) on a photographic topic of their choice.
- The project/topic can be anything: places, landscape, macro, colours, movement, star trails, flowers, portraits, sport, long exposure – the list is endless.

TIMEFRAME FOR SPRING 2019 SWM

- January: Communication(s) seeking volunteers can't progress until they are in place!
- When I have 12 volunteers (hopefully in place by the end of the month), I will e mail all members with details of the projects and ask them to give me their preferences
- Projects are allocated on a first come, first served basis so you need to respond quickly as some projects fill very fast
- When projects have been filled, leaders will contact their group and finalise details
- Leaders will collect €12 upfront from their groups which is the cost of printing for the showcase
- Projects will need to be finished towards the end of April to allow time for submitting and printing images for the showcase in May
